participation; and, the evaluation of College policies and procedures in the areas of student management, College rules and values, and Codes of Behaviour.

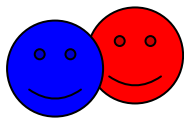
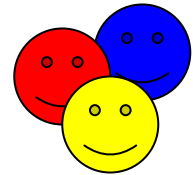
In 2008, the work will continue and the focus will be on Student Wellbeing. The team has planned a
